WHAT IS PRE-INSTALLATION?

Pre-installation is the process in which hardware such as hinges, door closers, exit devices, locks, electrified hardware, and flat goods are installed onto the doors prior to shipping to the jobsite. This process can save time, help meet deadlines, and provide a hassle-free jobsite installation.



BENEFITS OF PRE-INSTALLATION

- This allows doors to be delivered closer to the actual installation deadline, which reduces the potential for on-site damage.
- Pre-installation allows LaForce to catch manufacturing or product defects and fix them prior to delivering materials.
- This process also contributes to LEED construction. We recycle packaging at our shop and we will pick up packaging blocks and pallets, which saves jobsite waste.
- Hardware is applied by trained hardware installers in a controlled environment; no more guesswork!
